CRRSAA / HEERF II Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants

Wake Technical Community College signed and returned the Certification and Agreement to the US Department of Education offering assurance that the college intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students on April 15, 2020. The college received a Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA) Grant Award Notification from the US Department of Education on February 16, 2021 in the amount of \$5,195,425 for Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants and accepted the terms and conditions as outlined.

Status of Distribution of Funds

As of March 31, 2021, Wake Tech has distributed \$0 to 0 students in CRRSAA/HEERF II Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 314(a)(1) of the CRRSAA. During this period, students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants from CARES Act/HEERF I funds.

Eligibility

For the Spring 2021 term, 7,826 Wake Tech students were eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965.
