- ✓ 271 Wake Tech graduates (Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, & Associate in Applied Science) (2011-12) had an overall average GPA of 2.94 after their first year (2012-13) at a UNC System institution compared with UNC native juniors' overall average GPA of 2.92
- ✓ 522 Wake Tech students (who earned at least 30 semester hours at Wake Tech in 2011-12) transferred to a UNC System institution in 2012-13. These students had an average GPA of (2.82) compared with native UNC sophomores (2.83) after one year at a UNC institution.
