

## QUICK FACTS 2014-2015

Wake Tech served 29,025 students in curriculum (CU); 40,929 in workforce continuing education (WCE); and 28,155 students in an Algebra Review MOOC; 900+ students in a CheMOOC. Increase over 2013-2014 in **green**; Decreases in **red**

- ✓ 15,145 (-1.4%) enrolled students already have a BA degree or higher (22% of total student body)
- ✓ 10,925 (1.8%) students were awarded a Federal Pell Grant Total: \$35,179,594 (3.3%); \$3,220 (1.4%) average per student
- ✓ 15,054 (-0.9%) students were awarded some type of financial Loan assistance; Total: \$53,865,175 (3.2%); \$3,578 (4.2%) average per student
- ✓ 3,198 (2.8%) students graduated from Wake Tech with an associate degree, diploma, or certificate.
- ✓ Since Wake Tech began awarding degrees in 1963, over 50,233 (6.8%) individuals have earned an associate degree, diploma, or certificate through Wake Tech.
- ✓ In 2014-2015 Wake Tech awarded 360 (-63.1%) HSEs and 43 (-41.8%) Adult High School diplomas.
- ✓ Since Wake Tech began awarding degrees in 1963, over 22,900 (1.7%) individuals have earned their HSE through Wake Tech and over 2,650 (1.6%) individuals have earned their Adult High School diploma.
- ✓ In 2014-15 Wake Tech provided basic skills courses to 6,608 individuals. (-13.5%)
- ✓ In 2014-15 Wake Tech offered 6,590 CU; 7,034 WCE; 13,624 total class sections (1.7%). Some examples are:

### Student Performance

- ✓ 236 Wake Tech graduates (Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Applied Science) (2012-13) had an overall average GPA of 3.13 after their first year (2013-14) at a UNC System institution compared with UNC native juniors' overall average GPA of 3.04
- ✓ 278 Wake Tech students (who earned at least 30 semester hours at Wake Tech in 2012-2013) transferred to a UNC System institution in 2013-14. These students had an average GPA of (2.85) compared with native UNC sophomores (2.96) after one year at a UNC institution.

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## 2014-2015 Grants Development Report

Each year, Wake Technical Community College submits grant proposals to federal, state, and other funding sources to support innovative initiatives college wide. During the 2014-15 fiscal year, Wake Tech received grants for 21 projects totaling \$4.12 million included the following Wake Tech initiatives:

- U.S. Department of Education for intensive counseling services for Pell Grant recipients and gateway course redesign.
- Duke Energy Foundation for equipment to support inclusion of orbital and robotic welding instruction into the curriculum.
- Walmart Foundation and the Institute for Veterans and Military Families for accelerated training opportunities for veterans in cybersecurity, EMT, and apartment maintenance.
- Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation for continuation of the Completion by Design initiative to support degree attainment
