

#### **Unduplicated Headcount - Total**





# WTCC Unduplicated Headcount 2015-2016





### Total FTE





### FTE by Campus





### Number of Degrees/Certificates




#### **First Year Progression**




### **Curriculum Completion**




### College Transfer Performance – NCCCS



### Transfer-Out Rate (%)





#### Licensure and Certification Passing Rate --WTCC --NCCCS





# Workforce Continuing Education (Non-Credit) Enrollment Growth





# Customized Training Enrollment Growth








### Number of For-Credit Career Programs Credentials —Associate Degrees —Diplomas —Certificates






