# **Initial Steps for Admissions**

- Activate your Wake Tech Account

# **Academic Advising is Critical**

#### **Academic Advising is critical in transition to Registration:**

- The student MUST UNDERSTAND:
  - Course sequencing/PPG for program
  - Placement into Course Sequence
    - RISE Placement (transition, co-requisites, core)
    - Transfer Credits / Course Substitutions
  - How to calculate a balanced academic workload
  - Cyclical Timelines and Important Dates



## **Registration Process**

#### Follow the steps below to register for courses

- Find your Registration Priority Date
- Log in to Self-Service to register
- Follow Registration Guide / Self-Service Steps
- Complete Registration
- Pay Tuition and Fees by the Due Date
- Purchase Books and Supplies
- Get Instructions and Directions for the First Day of Class



## **Registration Timeline**

- Mar 24 Last day to withdraw with W
- **April 5 Schedule available for viewing**
- **April 12 Registration for Continuing Students begins**
- **April 21 Registration for New Students begins**
- **April 23 Registration for Visiting Students begins**

# **Tuition Payment Deadlines**

#### **SUMMER 2021**

- May 3, 2021 if Registered Between 4/12/2021 5/3/2021
- May 18, 2021 if Registered Between 5/4/2021 5/18/2021
   FALL 2021
- July 26, 2021 if Registered Between 4/12/2021 7/26/2021
- August 15, 2021 if Registered Between 7/27/2021 8/15/2021

**NOTE:** Make payment to avoid being dropped from classes!



## **Registration Issues**

#### **Pre-requisites/Co-requisites:**

- Students who have not met pre-requisite or co-requisite requirements for any AET course
  - Will NOT remain registered for that course.
- Registered students who have transcripts, grades, or work experience proving completion
  of pre-requisite or co-requisite requirements must see the Program Director or Department
  Head before the beginning of the semester to obtain an override.
- Official transcripts must be sent to Wake Tech's Admissions Office
  - Initiates the Transcript evaluation process.

#### **Time Conflicts:**

- Exceeding Retake Limits, and Overload (≥ 20 credit hours)
  - Issues resolved on an individual basis
  - Expected to repeat a course no more than 1 time
  - Contact the Program Director or Department Head



# **Registration Issues**

#### **Late Adds:**

- Courses may NOT be added after the end of Schedule Adjustment Week (Drop/Add period)
- Students with extenuating circumstances should speak to their Program
   Director or Department Head before the end of Schedule Adjustment Week

#### **Full Classes:**

- Wake Tech cannot guarantee any student entry into a class that is full
- It is critical that students register as early as possible
- Any student purged from a class due to non-payment will not be guaranteed entry into that class once it is full



### Reminders

- Submit Transcripts to get course credit
- Complete FAFSA early to avoid missing deadlines
- Monitor Wake Tech E-mail for all communications
- Register Early to ensure getting into courses
- Meet Payment Deadlines to avoid being purged from classes
- Attend 90% of Classes, both on campus and online
- Monitor Blackboard daily to stay up on requirements
