Academic Integrity

Requires Environment Conducive to Learning Based on:

- Commitment to Honesty, Truth, Fairness, Respect, and Integrity

Academic Integrity:

- Cheating and Plagiarism Violates Integrity of the Academic Process
- Academic Penalties are Evaluated per Student Code of Conduct

Note:

- Instructors should establish clear expectations about collaboration
- Students should submit original individual/group work
- When in doubt about cheating/plagiarism, contact instructors

Managing Student Concerns

AET Division Abides By:

- Student Code of Conduct, Rights, & Responsibilities
- Follows the AET Division **Chain of Command**

Student's Steps for Resolving Complaint or Grievance:

- Communicate Concern to the Instructor - Outside of Class Time
- If Not Satisfied, then Speak with **Program Director**
- If Matter is Still Unresolved, Schedule Appointment with **Department Head**, then **Division Dean**
 - **NOTE:** *Be prepared to explain reason for disagreement with prior decisions of the Instructor and Program Director*
