


ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

This articulation agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made between Wake Technical Community College (hereinafter "WTCC") and Baptist Health Sciences University (hereinafter "Baptist University") as they are desirous of cooperating in providing an undergraduate program of study that will lead to students receiving the Bachelor of Health Science in Neurodiagnostic Technology (hereinafter "NDT") degree from Baptist University. The degree is to be awarded if individual students successfully complete the requirements indicated in this articulation agreement.

In consideration of this mutual objective, WTCC and Baptist University each agree as follows:

1. Program Considerations.

- 1.1. Graduates of the WTCC Electroneurodiagnostic Technology program will follow the established admissions process at Baptist University. Candidates for admission from WTCC will be considered based upon the same selection criteria used for all applicants.
- 1.2. The Baptist University NDT program reserves the right to make changes in its admissions requirements at any time. The Baptist University website publishes current admission requirements.
- 1.3. Baptist University enrolls new students three times per year (January, April, and September). The Baptist University website publishes current application deadlines. All applicants are encouraged to start the application process at least six months before their desired matriculation.
- 1.4. The NDT curriculum from Baptist University shall consist of one hundred twenty-one (121) undergraduate semester hours. In addition, the specific undergraduate courses offered by WTCC and accepted by Baptist University as partial fulfillment of the credit hours for the Bachelor of Health Science in NDT, as shown on Exhibit A, hereto may be amended periodically by mutual consent.
- 1.5. It is understood that the parties may feature the affiliation in their catalogs and other promotional materials that may be used in recruiting and advising students interested in a career in NDT.
- 1.6. Each year, WTCC will invite the NDT Program Chair, or other Baptist University designee, to make a presentation to current Electroneurodiagnostic Technology students about the ability to transfer to Baptist University after graduation and apply academic credit earned through the AAS toward the Bachelor of Health Sciences degree.



1.7. The parties agree that they shall not illegally discriminate against any person in connection with this affiliation agreement on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, sex, disability or military service.

2. Applying to Baptist University.

2.1. To be considered for admission, a student must submit an application and official transcripts from every college attended. It should be sent directly from each college to the Baptist University Admission Office. A non-refundable application fee of \$25.00 must accompany each application.

3. <u>Degrees Awarded.</u>

- 3.1. A block of 53 credit hours will be awarded to the WTCC graduate upon successful completion of their first Baptist University NDT course. Prerequisite waivers may be requested while the block credit is pending and will be evaluated based on previous undergraduate coursework.
- 3.2. Upon successfully completing Baptist University NDT degree requirements, in accordance with all applicable rules and common practices for the awarding of degrees, students will be awarded the Bachelor of Health Science in Neurodiagnostic Technology from Baptist University.

4. Duration & Terms of Agreement.

- 4.1. This agreement shall be effective immediately upon the signing of this document and shall continue thereafter from year to year unless terminated by either party upon one hundred eighty (180) days advance written notice.
- 4.2. The terms of this agreement may be modified by mutual consent of both institutions. Any modifications shall be recorded in writing.
- 4.3. The Parties agree that the law of Tennessee without regard to the principles of choice or conflict of law shall govern the formation, construction and enforcement of this agreement.




EXHIBIT A
