

## Career and College Promise Self-Registration Notifications & Tips

Instructions: Please review the following information below prior to the beginning of the CCP Self-Registration period...

- CCP Self-Registration will begin on November 4<sup>th</sup> at 7:00AM.
- CCP Self-Registration will conclude
  - December 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59PM (Spring)

**NOTE:** Students must submit the Course Request Form after the Self-Registration Deadline for each Term.

- Applications (for New Students) and Continuing Student Forms must be approved by the CCP Team in order for students to obtain clearance to register for courses
  - New Students: New Student Orientation and the eLearning Intro Assessment must be completed to register for courses
  - 9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> Grade Students approved for the College Transfer Pathway must complete Mandatory CCP Academic Advising before their registration hold can be lifted
- Students will be dropped from registered courses for the following reasons:
  - **Registering for a course (or courses) beyond the maximum allowed credit within a discipline (College Transfer Pathway Only)**
    - Example: John Doe is enrolled in the Associate in Science Pathway. John has completed the maximum credits allowed (6 SHC) in the Humanities/Fine Arts/Communications discipline but has registered for an additional 3 SHC.
  - **Registering for two courses of the same subject within a particular discipline (College Transfer Pathway Only)**
    - Example: Jane Doe is enrolled in the Associate in Science Pathway, but registers for HIS-111 & HIS-112 within the Social/Behavioral Sciences Discipline (student must choose two different subjects).
  - **Registering for a course not within your approved pathway**
    - Example: Jane Doe has been approved for the Associate in Science Pathway (P1042C) but registered for PED-110 (not in the pathway)

## Examples (Self-Service View)

- **Registered for course outside of pathway (who is NOT a pathway completer)**
  - **Student's Pathway – Associate in Science (P1042C)**
  - **Course out of Pathway – HUM-110**
  - **\*Status would say "Registered"**

  - **Student’s Pathway – Associate in Arts (P1012C)**
  - **Pathway Discipline – Social/Behavioral Sciences**
  - **Rule – Take 9 Credits (Min of 2 subjects)**
  - **Course over maximum SHC – ECO-252**
  - **\*Status would say “Registered”**

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




- **Registered for a course (or courses) of the same subject within the discipline(s)**
  - **Student’s Pathway – Associate in Science (P1042C)**
    - **Associate in Arts (P1012C) would allow this restriction since 9 Credits can be taken**
  - **Pathway Discipline – Social/Behavioral Sciences**
  - **Rule – Take 6 Credits (and 2 subjects)**
  - **Issue – ECO-251 & ECO-252; ECO-252 makes the student “out of compliance”**
  - **\*Status would say “Registered”**
