

What is the Chemistry MOOC? The Wake Tech Chemistry MOOC covers the same topics in a CHM 090 (Chemistry Concepts) course. The difference is, the MOOC is self-paced and there is no professor teaching it. It's an online review, followed by an optional chemistry challenge exam (equivalent to a final exam in CHM 090). A CHM 090 course would have a professor teaching it and has additional support built-in to the course.

Why would I use the MOOC? It's free review for students needing to refresh on conversions, stoichiometry, and all things developmental chemistry! You can also use the Chemistry MOOC as an alternative to Chemistry 090! By successfully completing the proctored challenge exam, you can satisfy the Wake Tech prerequisite of CHM 090 (more details below).

How do I enroll in the Chemistry MOOC? The Chemistry MOOC is now on Wake Tech's Blackboard platform, so you can access it the same way you would your class sites.

How do I take the challenge exam? Once you complete 70% of available MOOC quiz points, contact Prof. Whitehead by Teams or email at jrwhitehead@waketech.edu. Following this, the eLTC will contact to schedule your exam. Passing the challenge exam awards a prerequisite equivalent for CHM 090 for use at WTCC. There is no charge for the MOOC or the challenge exam at this time, and there is a six month waiting period to re-take the challenge exam.

Challenge exams are not available during semester breaks, nor during the first or last two weeks of each semester.
