

The following items must be completed before you can submit a Nursing Program Application checklist.

- Become a Wake Tech student at apply.waketech.edu
- Complete a Nursing information session.** Go to hsinfosession.waketech.edu for more information. *Students must complete information session before meeting with a health sciences advisor.*
- Submit required educational transcripts.** Once received, your file will be reviewed for admissions and course placement. If you have college transcripts, verify transcripts are evaluated. Log in to Self-Service. Go to Student Planning → Select Transfer Credits from the Academics menu at the top. If your course is not there, please email tranevalreq@waketech.edu *It is the student's responsibility to follow up with Student Records for transfer credit.*
- Meet math proficiency with one of the following:** *(Must be within 10 years of Nursing program application date)*
 - Met high school GPA waiver through either Multiple Measures or RISE.
 - Meet minimum scores on placement test (ACT/SAT/CPT/GED/HiSET)
 - Complete a college level math class with a "C" or better
 - Provide verification of completion of an associate's degree or higher
 - Successfully complete MAT 003, Tier 1 or equivalent
- Meet English/Reading proficiency with one of the following:**
 - Met high school GPA waiver through either Multiple Measures or RISE.
 - Met appropriate scores on placement test (ACT/SAT/CPT/GED/HiSET)
 - Complete ENG 111 or equivalent with a "C" or better
 - Provide proof of completion of an associate's degree or higher
- Meet Science requirement with one of the following:**
 - Meet prerequisite to take BIO 168 (CHM 090, BIO 110, BIO 111, high school chemistry, CheMOOC)
 - Complete BIO 168 with a "C" or better within 5 years of first NUR class
- Take the TEAS test: Register for TEAS test at atitesting.com**
 - Composite score of 59% or higher is required to submit NUR program application.
 - The TEAS can be taken twice in a calendar year with a minimum of 30 days between each test.
 - Official scores from ATI must be received by application deadline.
- Meet NC Nurse Aide requirement. For more information, go to <https://ncnar.ncdhhs.gov/>**
 - Applicant must be listed on the NC Nurse Aide registry as a Nurse Aide I by the program application deadline. Provide current NCNAR listing when submitting the program application. Listing must remain current through the first day of NUR 111.
 - A current NA 2 or LPN license can be used to meet the Nurse Aide requirement.
 - The Nursing department reserves the right to make changes to the Nurse Aide requirement. Speak with a Health Sciences advisor to verify the Nurse Aide requirement for your program application deadline.
- Complete English Language proficiency requirement.** Form attached to the Nursing program application.
 - If TOEFL is required, take the exam and submit official scores by application deadline.
- Submit program application. All the above requirements MUST BE COMPLETED by the application deadline:**
 - Application deadline January 31 for Fall NUR entry
 - Application deadline July 31 for Spring NUR entry

Competitive Admissions Process

To select applicants for programs with limited clinical spaces, Wake Tech uses a competitive admission procedure with a point system – NOT a waiting list. Those applicants with the highest number of points will be selected. Applicants will be assigned points for general education courses that are part of the Associate Degree Nursing curriculum that have been completed by the application deadline.

- January 31 application deadline: points will be accrued for classes completed through the prior fall semester.
- July 31 application deadline: points will be accrued through the summer semester.

How to Calculate Your Points

Additional points will be awarded based on the TEAS composite scores as follows:

- 71-80 = 6pts;
- 81-90 = 12pts;
- 91+ = 20 pts

Note the following:

- To receive points for BIO 168 (Anatomy & Physiology I), BIO 169 (Anatomy & Physiology II) and BIO 175 (Microbiology), the class must be completed within 5 years of the first NUR class. If you have completed BOTH BIO 168 and BIO 169, the 5 year requirement is based upon the completion date of BIO 169.
- All BIO classes must have an associated lab.
- If students receive credit based on AP, CLEP, or DANTES exam scores, points will be award equivalent to a “B” – 9 points. AP, CLEP, or DANTES exams will not be accepted for BIO classes. Remember to submit official exam scores to Wake Tech to be eligible for the college credit.
- If grade of “B” or a “C” is earned in a class, the class can be retaken. Points will be based on the highest grade earned. If a grade of “D, F, or WF” is earned in a class, 0 (zero) points will be awarded, and the class must be repeated to earn a minimum “C” grade.

HUMANITIES/FINE ARTS ELECTIVE: The Humanities/Fine Arts elective can be any 3 credit hour class focusing on religion, art, literature, philosophy, drawing, sculpting, painting, music, dance, and theatre. Only 1 (one) class is required. Choices can include any of the following but speak with an advisor for other choices:

ART 111 ART 114 ART 115 HUM 115 MUS 110 MUS 112 PHI 215 PHI 240

The Nursing department is constantly evaluating the admissions procedures and reserves the right to make changes as the need arises.
