The Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP) is pleased to inform you of its vote on **May 20, 2022** to award **initial accreditation** to the Neurodiagnostic Technology program at Wake Technical Community College, Raleigh, NC.

The recent peer review conducted by the Committee on Accreditation for Education in Neurodiagnostic Technology (CoA-NDT) and CAAHEP's Board of Directors recognizes the program's compliance with the nationally established accreditation Standards. The next evaluation of the program is scheduled to occur no later than **2027**.

The CoA-NDT will regularly monitor the program's compliance with the outcomes assessment thresholds through the program's Annual Report as well as other documentation that may be requested (Standard IV.B.).
