Welcome back to a new academic year! We hope you had a wonderful and restful break, and are now ready to embark on another exciting chapter of your educational journey.

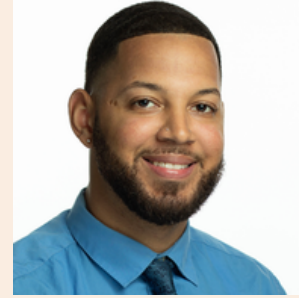
