

QUICK FACTS 2015-2016

Wake Tech served 29,529 students in curriculum (CU); 40,951 in workforce continuing education (WCE); and 30,225 students in an Algebra Review MOOC; 900+ students in a CheMOOC; 1,097 in College Reading & Writing MOOC. Increase over 2014-2015 in **green**; Decreases in **red**

- ü 14,868 (-1.8%) enrolled students already have a BA degree or higher (22% of total student body)
- ü 10,440 (-4.4) students were awarded a Federal Pell Grant Total: \$38,341,357 (9%); \$3,673 (14%) average per student
- ü 12,973 (-13.8) students were awarded some type of financial Loan assistance; Total: \$48,362,746 (-10.2%); \$3,728 (4.2%) average per student
- ü 2,944 (-7.9%) students graduated from Wake Tech with an associate degree, diploma, or certificate.
- ü Since Wake Tech began awarding degrees in 1963, over 53,177 (14.5%) individuals have earned an associate degree, diploma, or certificate through Wake Tech.
- ü In 2015-2016 Wake Tech awarded 604 (67.8%) HSEs and 80 (86.0%) Adult High School diplomas.
- ü Since Wake Tech began awarding degrees in 1963, over 23,500 (2.6%) individuals have earned their HSE through Wake Tech and over 2,730 (3%) individuals have earned their Adult High School diploma.
- ü In 2015-16 Wake Tech provided basic skills courses to 7,185 individuals. (10.5%)
- ü In 2015-16 Wake Tech offered 6,691 CU; 6720 WCE; 13,411 total class sections (-1.6%). Some examples are:

Student Performance

- ü 233 Wake Tech graduates (Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, Associate in Applied Science) (2013-14) had an overall average GPA of 3.12 after their first year (2014-15) at a UNC System institution compared with UNC native juniors' overall average GPA of 3.06
- ü 359 Wake Tech students (who earned at least 30 semester hours at Wake Tech in 2013-2014) transferred to a UNC System institution in 2014-15. These students had an average GPA of (2.82) compared with native UNC sophomores (2.95) after one year at a UNC institution.
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2015-2016 Grants Development Report

Each year, Wake Technical Community College submits grant proposals to federal, state, and other funding sources to support innovative initiatives college wide. During the 2015-16 fiscal year, Wake Tech received grants for 25 projects totaling \$7.92 million included the following Wake Tech initiatives:

- U.S. US Department of Education's First in the World program will improve success of minority students in high demand online courses through redesign and increased support services.
- National Science Foundations' GEOPATHS project will create new research opportunities for students in the geosciences programs.
- National Endowment for the Humanities 'America's Wars' project will incorporate the recollection of veterans into 5 humanities courses and create symposia for students and faculty on the effects of armed conflict upon our national fabric
- US Department of Labor's TechHire program will create new training opportunities for disadvantaged youth and adults in information technology and cybersecurity training
