PREPARING TO TAKE THE **TEAS**

Wake Tech does not provide TEAS testing. Students can take the exam online with ATI and can schedule a test at atitesting.com.

The **Test of Essential Academic Skills** (**TEAS**) was developed to measure essential skills in the academic areas of reading, mathematics, science, and English and language usage. These entry-level skills have been deemed important for health sciences program applicants by a panel of curriculum experts.

When to Test: The TEAS is an expensive test, and you have limited attempts. We encourage students to test when they feel that they are thoroughly prepared. The test covers English, Math, and Science. Students typically are more successful after completing related courses that are required for their program, such as ENG 111, ENG 112, BIO 168 and BIO 169 or BIO 163.

Scoring: TEAS points are based on the Composite Score, which is an average of an applicant's reading, math, science, and English and language usage scores. We do not go by the score that is printed on the score report. Applicants may take the TEAS multiple times; their highest score in each area will be used in calculating the Composite Score. Note that TEAS scores are reported as percentages, in decimal format (e.g., 70.5%). TEAS scores will be rounded up or down to the nearest whole number (.4 or lower will be rounded down; .5 or higher will be rounded up).

Version: Wake Tech accepts ATI TEAS Version 7, ATI TEAS, and TEAS V scores as long as they are within three years of your specific program application deadline. TEAS 4 or lower will not be accepted.

Time Limit: Scores are valid 3 years prior to the clinical application deadline.

Testing Frequency: You can take the test only twice per calendar year with a minimum of 30 days in between tests attempts.
