

Transfer Student Checklist

1. Academic Preparation

Meet with an Academic Advisor: Review your degree plan and ensure all courses align with transfer requirements.

Verify Course Transferability: Use transfer equivalency tools or check with the university to confirm credits will transfer.

Complete General Education Requirements: Ensure all prerequisites for your intended major are completed.

Maintain a Strong GPA: Many universities require a minimum GPA for transfer. Aim to exceed this standard.

2. Application Process

Research Application Deadlines: Note the deadlines for both the university and specific programs.

Submit Your Application: Complete the application via the university's admissions portal.

Write a Personal Statement/Essay (if required): Highlight your academic journey and goals.

Request Transcripts: Send official transcripts from your community college and any other institutions attended.

Apply for Financial Aid: Complete the FAFSA and any additional university-specific financial aid applications. Upload school FAFSA Codes.

Pay Application Fees or Submit Fee Waivers: Ensure all fees are paid or waivers are approved.

3. Financial Planning

Search for Scholarships: Look for transfer-specific scholarships and apply early. (CFNC Scholarships. Scholarship Workshops.)

Review Tuition Costs and Payment Plans: Understand the costs and create a financial plan.

Set Up Financial Aid at Your New School: Verify that your aid package has been processed.

4. University Transition

Confirm Acceptance: Respond to your admission offer by the deadline.

Attend Transfer Orientation: Learn about campus resources, academic policies, and your program requirements.

Register for Classes: Work with an advisor at your new university to schedule classes.

Explore Housing Options: Secure on-campus or off-campus housing, if needed.

Get Familiar with Campus Resources: Learn about libraries, career services, tutoring, and health centers.

5. Final Steps

Meet Graduation Requirements at the Community College: If earning an associate degree, ensure all requirements are met.

Request Final Transcripts Post-Graduation: Send updated transcripts reflecting your completed degree or coursework.

Connect with Peer Mentors: Join transfer student organizations or mentorship programs to build connections.
