

Description of the Cohort Represented:

Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity and Gender: Fall 2022 (or most recent fall term with reported data) Distance Education Enrollment: Fall 2022

Retention Rates: First-time, full-time students from Fall 2021, tracked to Fall 2022

Graduation and Transfer-Out Rates: First-time, degree/certificate-seeking students from the Fall 2019 cohort, tracked for three years to 2022.

Comparison Colleges Represented:

Public two-year colleges in the United States with enrollments exceeding 10,000 students. Examples include Lone Star College System, Houston Community College, Miami Dade College, Valencia College, and others.

Definitions of Variables:

Ebrollment by Race/Ethnicity (Black or African American): Percentage of students self-identified as Black or African American. Encollment by Race/Ethnicity (Hispanic/Latino): Percentage of students self-identified as Hispanic or Latino. Encollment by Gender (Female): Percentage of students self-identified as female. Excelusively Distance Education: Percentage of students enrolled exclusively in online or distance education courses.

Resention Rate (Full-time):

Percentage of first-time, full-time students who returned the following fall.

Graduation Rate:

Percentage of first-time, degree/certificate-seeking students completing their program within 150% of normal time.

Transfer-Out Rate:

Percentage of first-time students who transferred to another institution within 150% of normal time.

Source of Data:

Data retrieved from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

Data represents the most recent cohorts available as of December 2024.
