Thank you for your letter of October 22, 2012, notifying the Commission on Colleges that Wake Technical Community College is reporting the addition of a clinical site outside the service area for the college's nursing degree program and the termination of the Simulation and Game Development collaborative agreement with Fayetteville Technical Community College. The termination of the collaborative agreement with Fayetteville Technical Community College connected with the Simulation and Game Development Associate degree was effective December 2010. The termination of the collaborative agreement was instigated by Fayetteville Technical College and has since implemented their own Simulation and Game Development Associate Degree program. At the time this agreement was terminated there were no Fayetteville Tech Community College students taking the courses in Wake Tech's program.

**We approve the termination of the agreement with Fayetteville Technical Community College which involved offering the Simulation and Game Development Associate Degree and require no additional information.**

The College has added a new clinical site for its Associate Degree Nursing students in Johnston County, effective October 1, 2012. The location is:

Students complete all course work at the Health Science Campus of Wake Tech and this clinical site provides the opportunity for observational and practical experience designed to supplement didactic instruction provided by the college.
