Dear Dr. Boone:

Thank you for your letter of notification, dated May 8, 2013, regarding Wake Technical and Community College's intent to terminate academic programs, effective fall of 2013.

Programs identified as terminated programs include the following:

- Machining: Technology Associate degree, diploma, and certificate
- Machining: CNC certificate
- Machining: Tool and Die Associate degree, and certificate

All of the identified programs have been closed to new students since 2009. There are no students currently enrolled in these programs, nor has the institution awarded any of the program credentials to students since 2008.

The one full-time faculty member connected with these programs retired in 2009; adjunct faculty members have taught specific machining courses which were previously a component of other Applied Technologies degrees. However, due to state-wide changes as a result of the Curriculum Improvement Plan (CIP), none of the machining courses are now required for other Applied Technology degrees as of fall of 2013.

The Commission on Colleges approves termination of the identified programs, will include this information in the institution's files, and requests no additional information from you.
