Thank you for your letter of April 29, 2014, providing notification of the termination of three programs, effective fall 2014.

The programs to be terminated are as follows:

- Computer Engineering Technology A.A.S. Degree
- Industrial Engineering Technology A.A.S. Degree
- Landscaping Architecture Technology A.A.S. Degree

Students remaining in the programs have been notified via email concerning the program termination. They will be allowed to complete their degree program within two years or transfer into another similar program.

The one full-time faculty member in the Computer Engineering Technology program will transfer to the Electronics Engineering Technology program and thus will not be adversely affected by the closure of the program. The only faculty member connected with the Industrial Engineering Technology program has retired. The faculty member connected with the Landscaping Architecture Technology program will transition to other programs and thus will not be adversely affected by the closure.

We approve the closure of the three programs listed above.
