Thank you for your letter of May 24, 2017, responsive to our request of May 18, 2017, for additional information regarding the closure of the off-campus instructional site at the Johnston County Workforce Development Center, effective fall 2017. The site is:

The institution has terminated an Instructional Service Agreement (ISA) with Johnston Community College to jointly offer the Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program in Pharmacy Technology at this site. A signed copy of the termination form was provided. The institution will continue to offer the A.A.S. degree program at its Perry Health Science Campus.

The 29 students enrolled in the program were advised in spring 2017, about the closing and given the option of completing their program at either the institution or Johnston Community College. Sixteen of these students opted to complete their degree program at the institution. Beginning in fall 2017, they will attend all classes for this program at the institution's Perry Health Science Campus. No additional expenses will be incurred.

All of the faculty in the A.A.S. degree program in Pharmacy Technology teaching at the site are Johnston Community College faculty. The institution will hire new faculty to teach the courses that are moving from this site to the Perry Health Sciences Center.

The Commission approves the closure of the Johnston County Workforce Development Center off-campus instructional site and requests no additional information.
