Thank you for your letter of June 24, 2014, notifying the Commission of your intent to close the Associate in General Education Degree program, effective spring 2015, and for the teach-out plan for the program.

The teach-out plan for the Associate in General Education Degree program provides the following information:

- No new students will be admitted as of spring 2015.
- Currently enrolled students will be allowed to complete the Associate in General Education degree or to transfer to another credit program at the College.
- Facilities will not be impacted by the closure of the program.
- Impact on faculty will be minimal as faculty will continue to teach courses applicable to other credit programs.
- A teach-out agreement with another institution is not required.
